Notes on the crediting of achievements in the module Expertise (4)

The fourth module of the doctoral program "Expertise" promotes professional exchange, knowledge transfer and (international) research networking. The doctoral candidates should acquire and deepen subject-specific and interdisciplinary scientific knowledge. To this end, the doctoral candidates should

- o actively participate in scientific seminars/ conferences/ symposiums/ doctoral seminars (through own presentations in the form of lectures or poster sessions) or
- o publish articles in academic journals.

In order to credit the achievements in the Doctoral College (module 4) the application must be completed and signed by the doctoral candidate and his/her supervisor at the FH. Active participation in scientific seminars etc. must be documented by a certificate including type, location and time of the event as well as the contribution/ presentation of the doctoral candidate (scope and topic). The presentation documents must also be submitted. For the crediting of a scientific publication, a copy/ scan of the published paper must be submitted, showing the complete bibliographical details.

The scientific committee or individual members decide on the amount of ECTS based on the documents submitted. The following ECTS scheme is used as a basis:
